Our Program

Welcome to the YMCA of Vincennes Child Watch Program. We want your child's stay to be a safe and positive experience. Each child is regarded as a unique individual who needs to be understood, guided, encouraged and appreciated. This program will offer socialization opportunities and age appropriate recreational activities for your child. Y Child Watch is provided for members and non-members, and is for participants from 6 weeks to 6 years old. YMCA Staff are certified in CPR and First Aid.

Our Guidelines

- Child Watch is designed for short term needs only.
- Parents using YMCA Child Watch must sign their child in with a YMCA Child Watch attendant.
- Drop-offs may be denied service if child to adult ratio exceeds an acceptable number.
- Infants should be and dry upon arriving at the Child Watch area.
- Older children should bring a filled sippie cup.
- Children will only be released to persons authorized on the pick-up list.
- Hours are subject to change.

Child Watch attendants will notify you for the following reasons:

- Your child cries for more than 15 minutes.
- Your child is displaying symptoms of or is running a fever.

Personal Belongings

Please label all personal belongings you bring with your child. All children must wear a shirt (chest covered) and shorts/pants (diaper covered).

Illness Policy

For the protection of all children, the following guidelines have been adopted in accordance with the Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the Academy of Pediatrics. A Child cannot be signed into the program if any of the following exist:

- Fever within 24 hours
- vomiting or diarrhea within 24 hours
- Symptoms of childhood disease
- Any unexplained rash
- Any skin infection
- Pink eye
- Yellow green nose discharge

If your child has special circumstances (allergies, etc.), please notify a Child Watch attendant.

Emergency Procedures

Please note that in case of a building evacuation, all Child Watch children will be taken to the main parking lot.
