Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Certified Teacher or special certification a plus
- Fitness for Duty
- Must Possess a passion for helping students learn
- Must have the drive to help students find new ways to look at difficult skills and concepts.
- Requires the ability to have patience and a positive attitude.
- The ability to provide fun new ways to motivate students.

Principle Job Activities

- Your main responsibility is to help students learn
- Reviewing Content with students and explain how to solve problems and checking completed work.
- Help students develop study skills and organization techniques to help improve their academic performance.
- Keep reports on students and share those reports with supervisors, teachers, and parents.
