Your Civil Rights

YMCA VanGo operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and other statutes and authorities that prohibit discrimination in Federally assisted programs and activities. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title IV may file a complaint with YMCA VanGo. Discrimination Complaint Procedures

YMCA VanGo has established a process for riders to file a complaint under Title VI. Any person who believes that she or he has been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by YMCA VanGo may file a Title IV complaint by completing and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint available at our administrative offices or on our website www.ymcavincennes.org

YMCA VanGo will notify INDOT of all formal complaints within five business days of receiving the complaint.
